

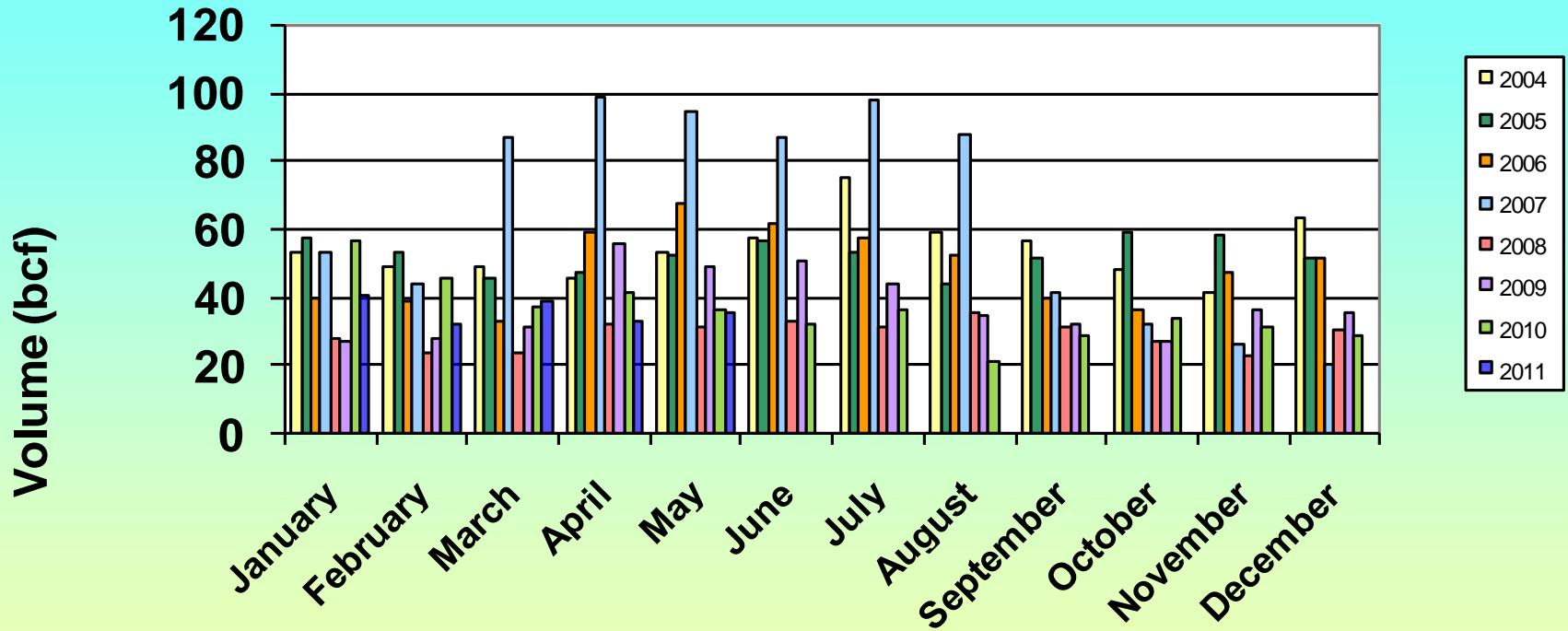


U.S. LNG Imports and Exports 2004 – 2011



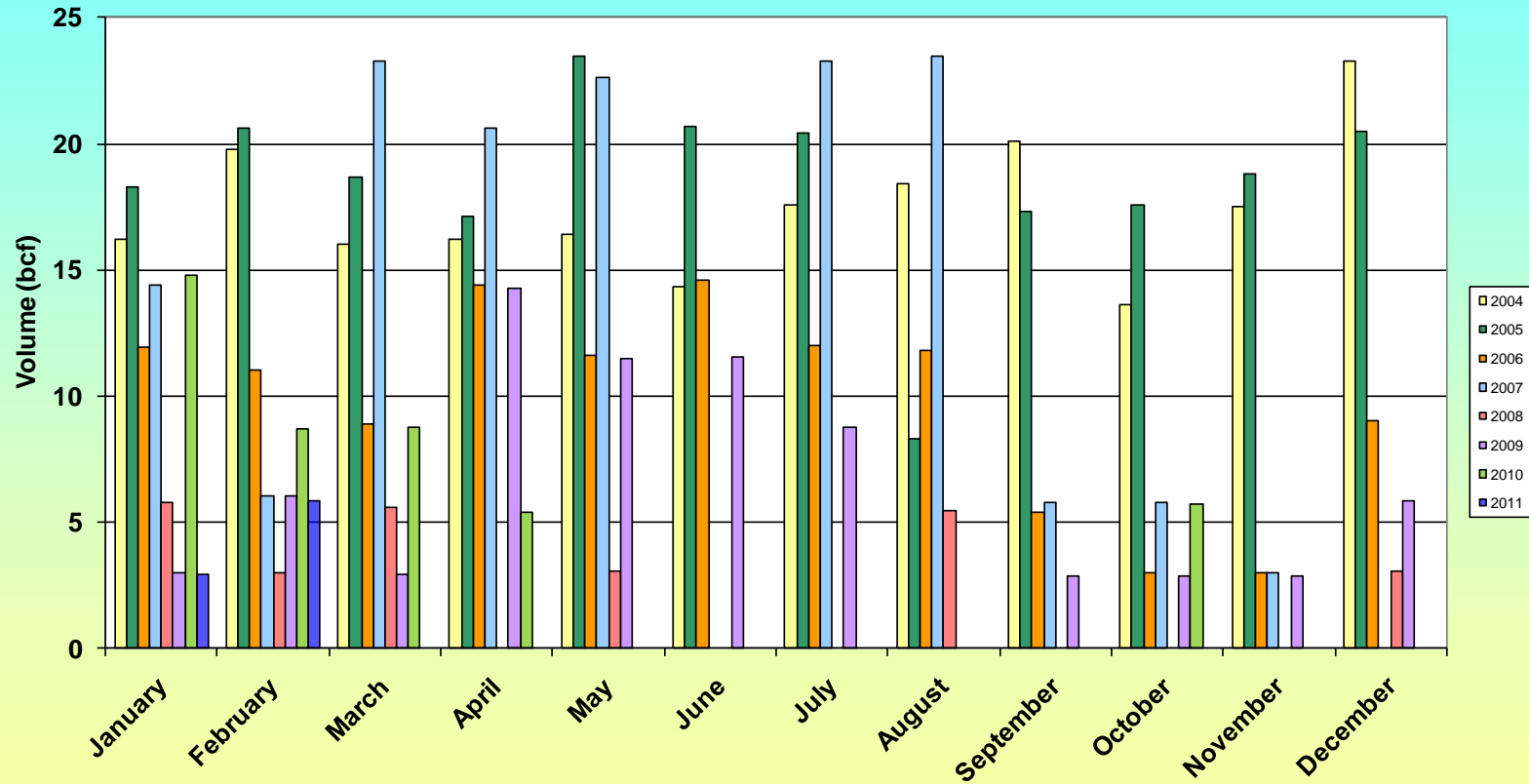

Monthly LNG Imports – All CONUS Terminals 2004 – 2011

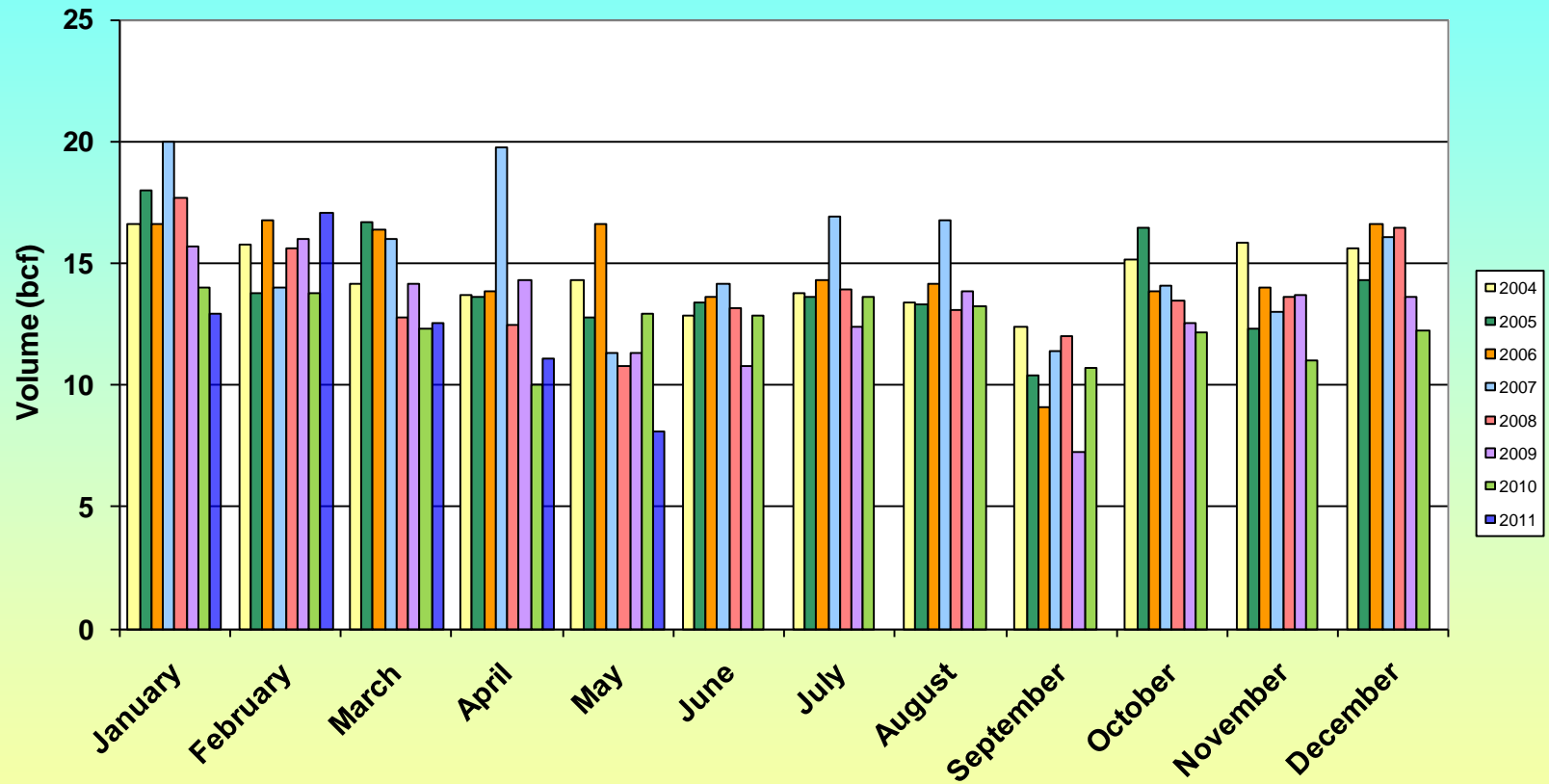




Monthly LNG Imports – Cove Point 2004 – 2011

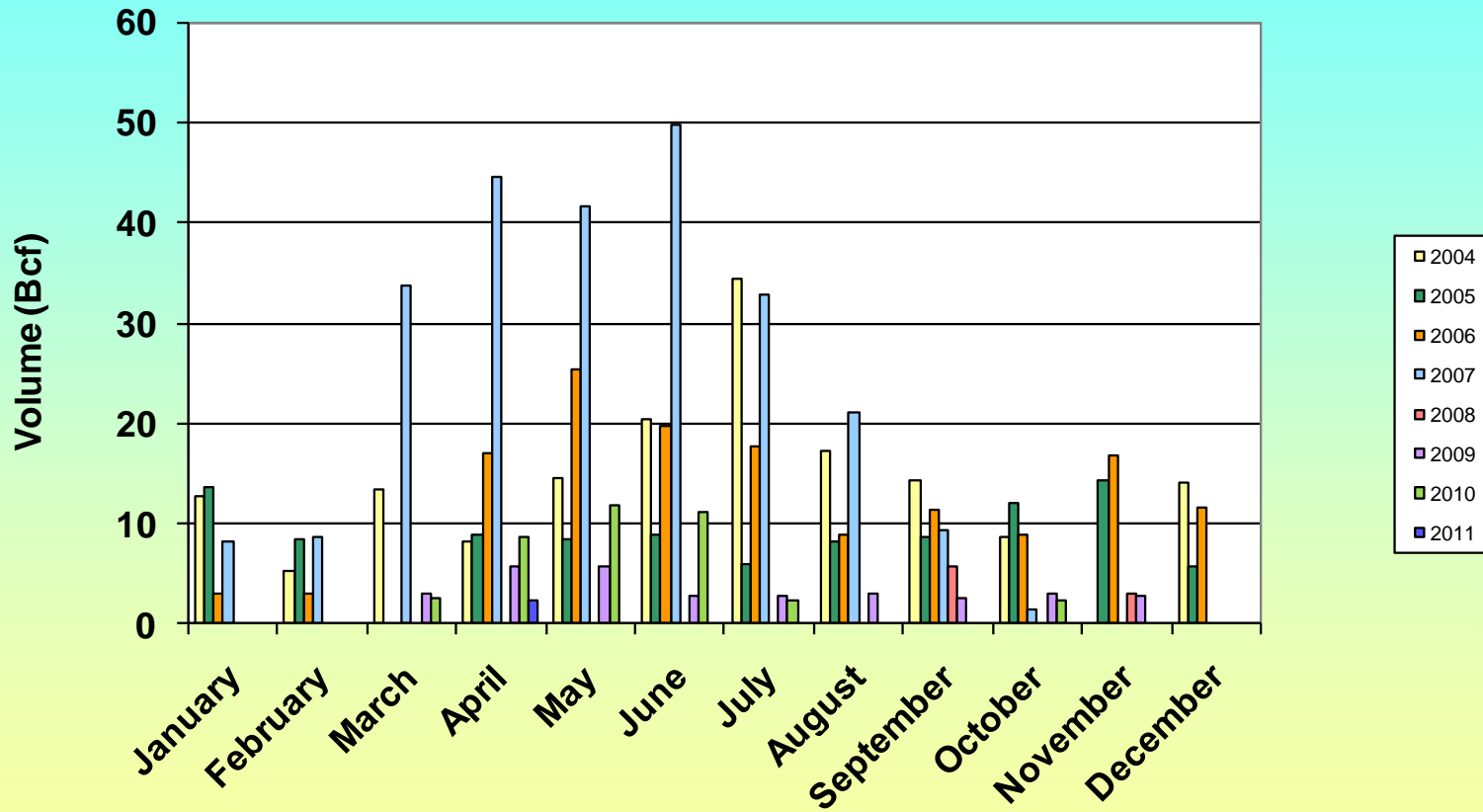


Monthly LNG Imports – Everett 2004 – 2011



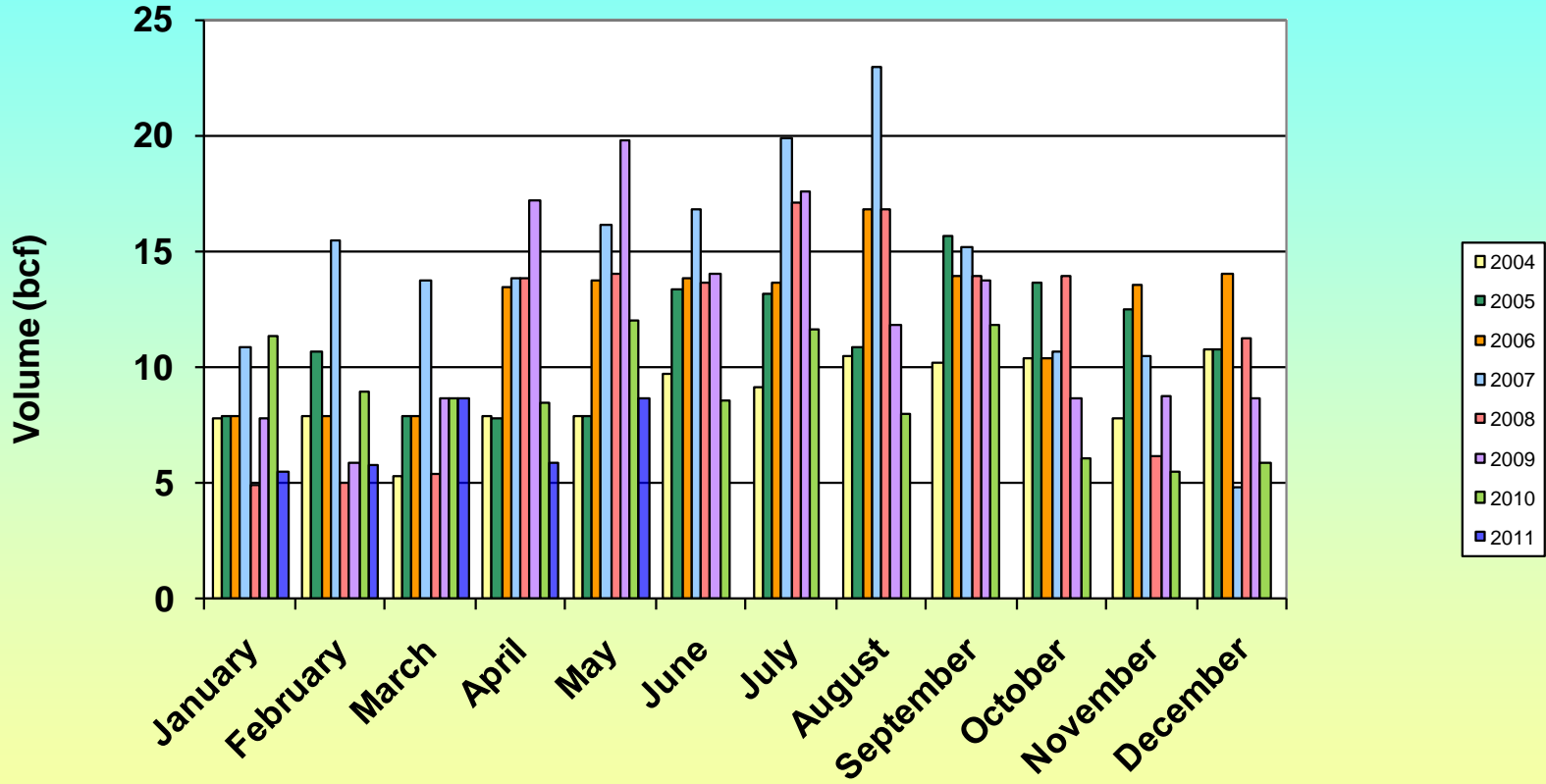


Monthly LNG Imports – Lake Charles 2004 – 2011

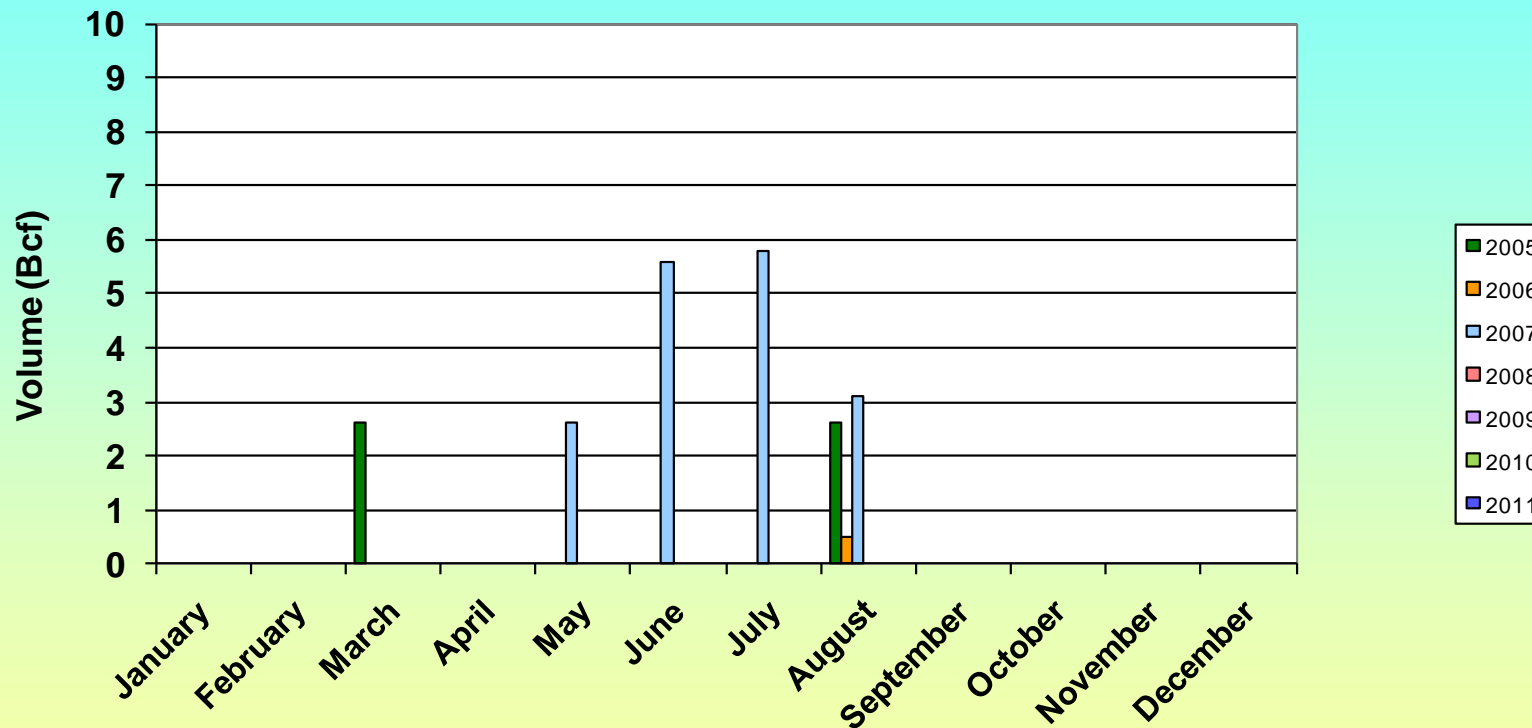




Monthly LNG Imports – Elba Island 2004 – 2011



Monthly LNG Imports – Gulf Gateway Energy Bridge 2005 – 2011

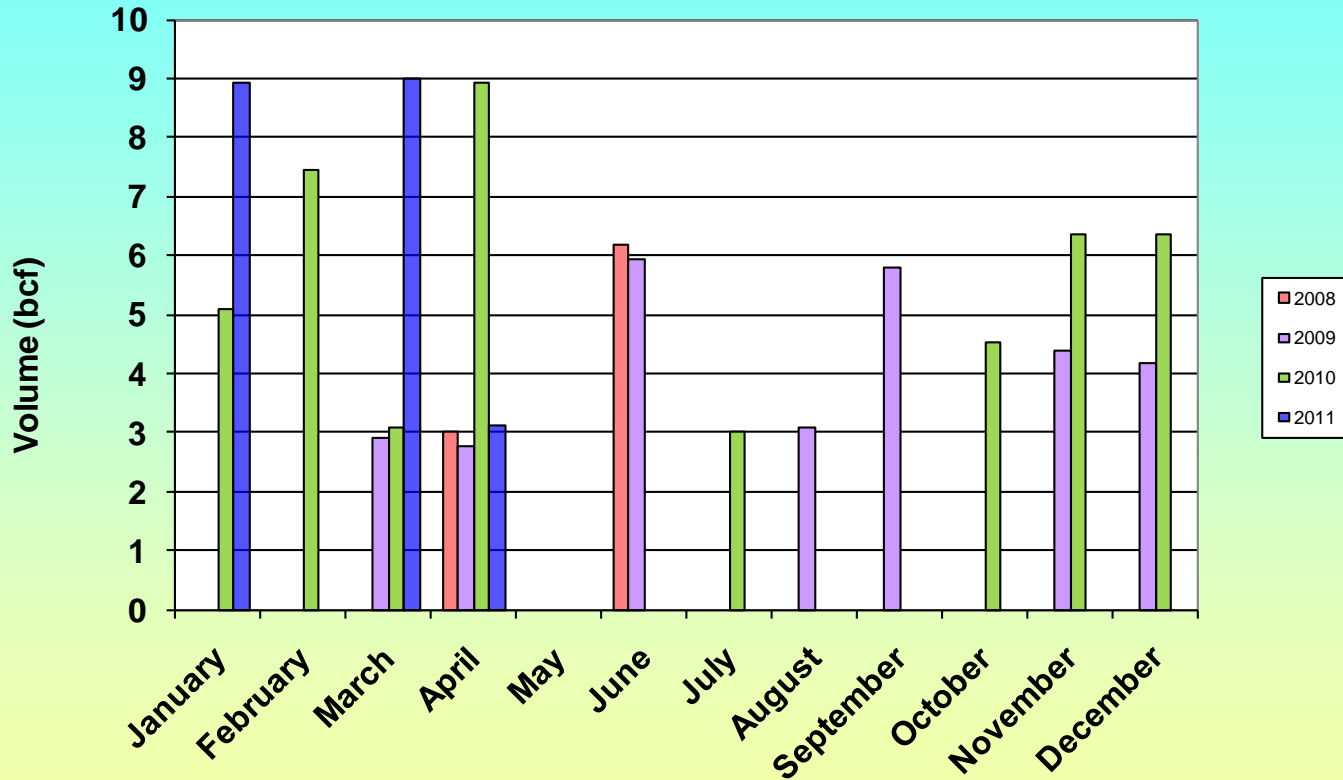


Gulf Gateway received its first cargo in March 2005. Excelerate Energy has announced that it will retire the Gulf Gateway terminal in the near future.

* March 2007 cargo containing 115 Mcf is not large enough to appear on this graph.

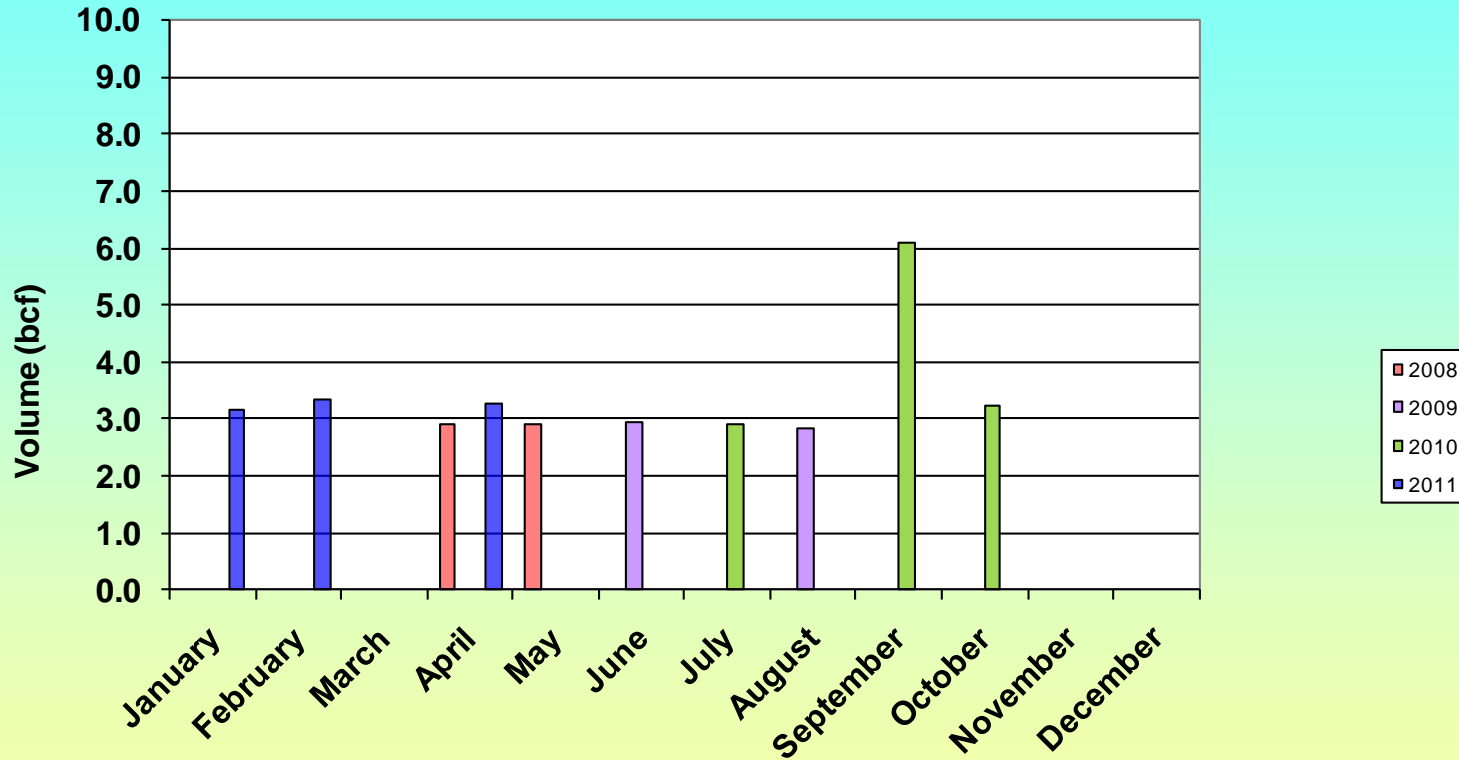


Monthly LNG Imports – Sabine Pass 2008 – 2011



Sabine Pass received its first cargo in April 2008.

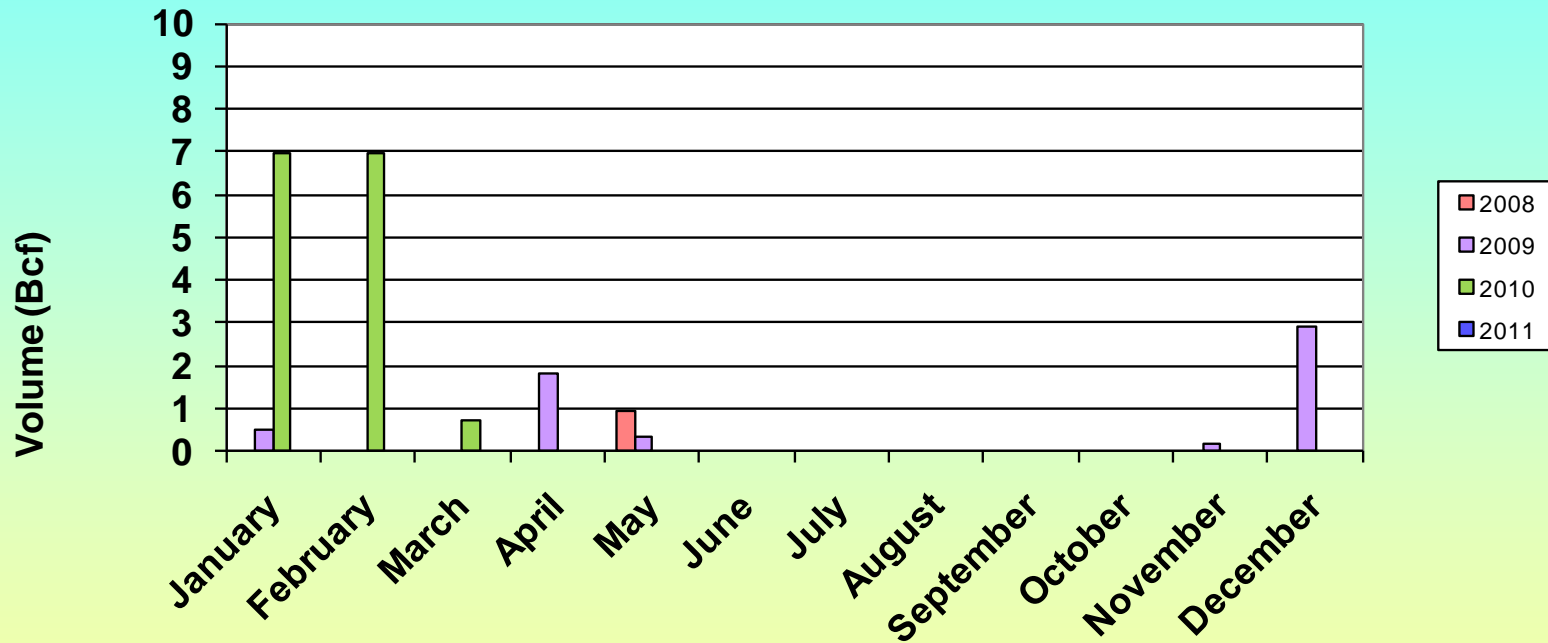
Monthly LNG Imports – Freeport 2008 – 2011



Freeport received its first cargo in April 2008.



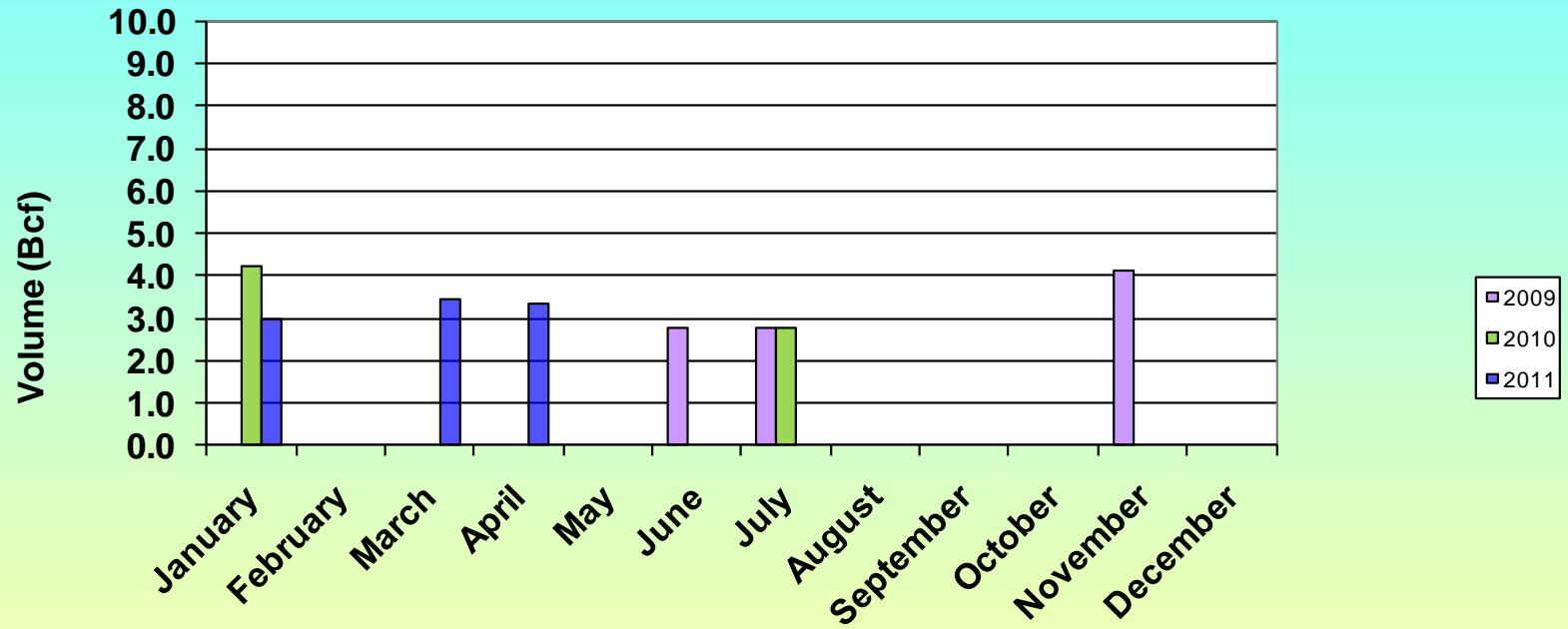
Monthly LNG Imports – Northeast Gateway Energy Bridge 2008 – 2011



Northeast Gateway received its first cargo in May 2008.

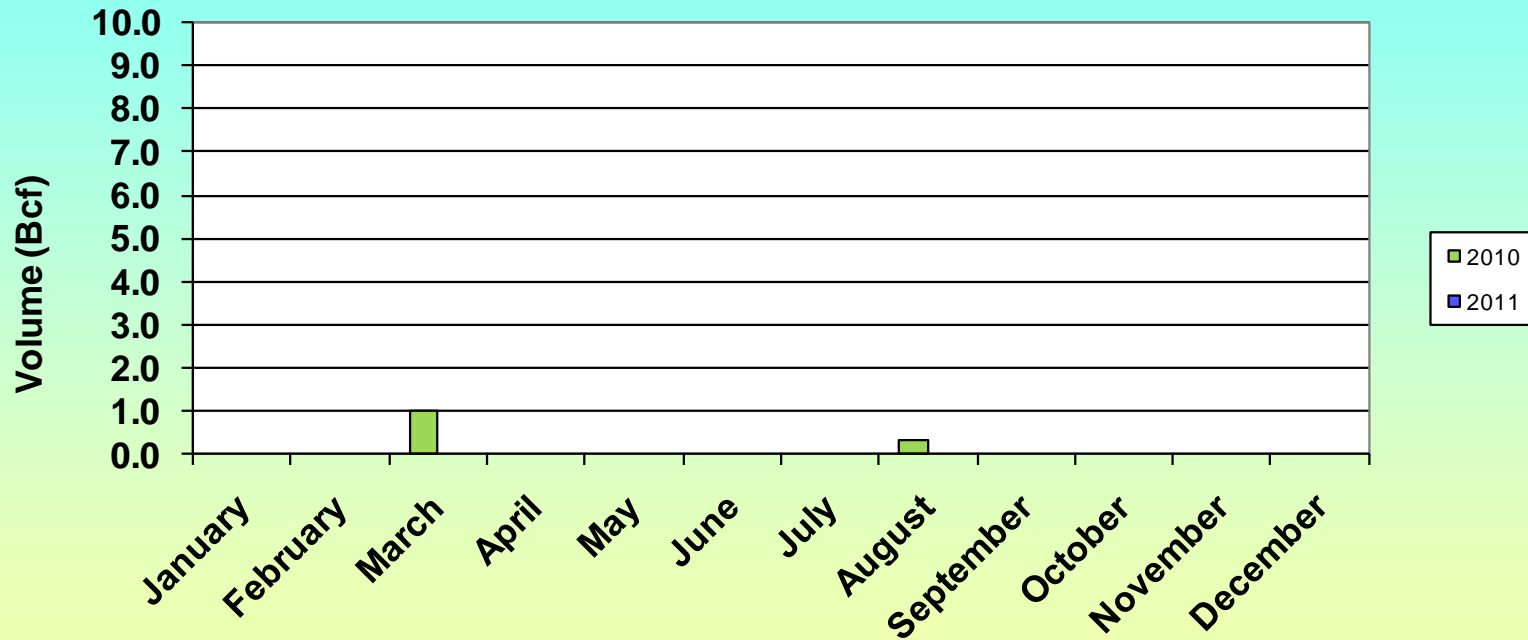


Monthly LNG Imports – Cameron 2009-2011



Cameron received its first cargo in June 2009.

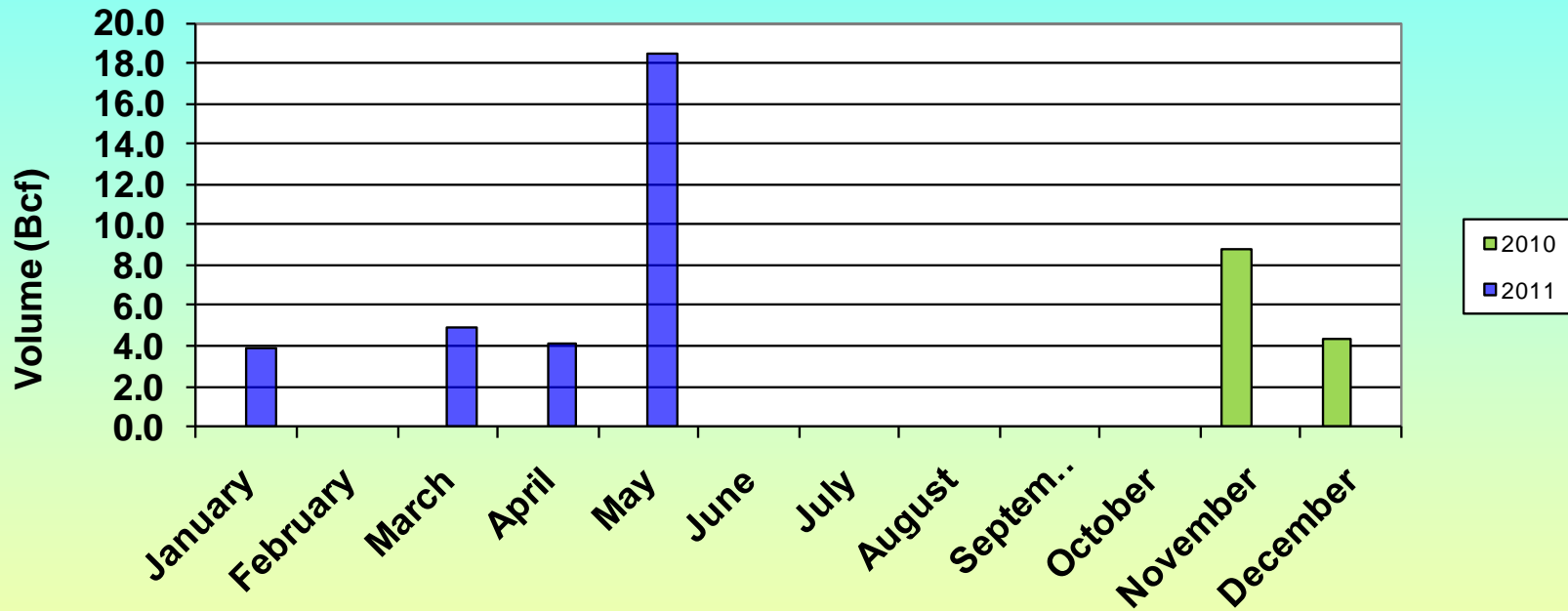
Monthly LNG Imports – Neptune Deepwater Port 2010-2011

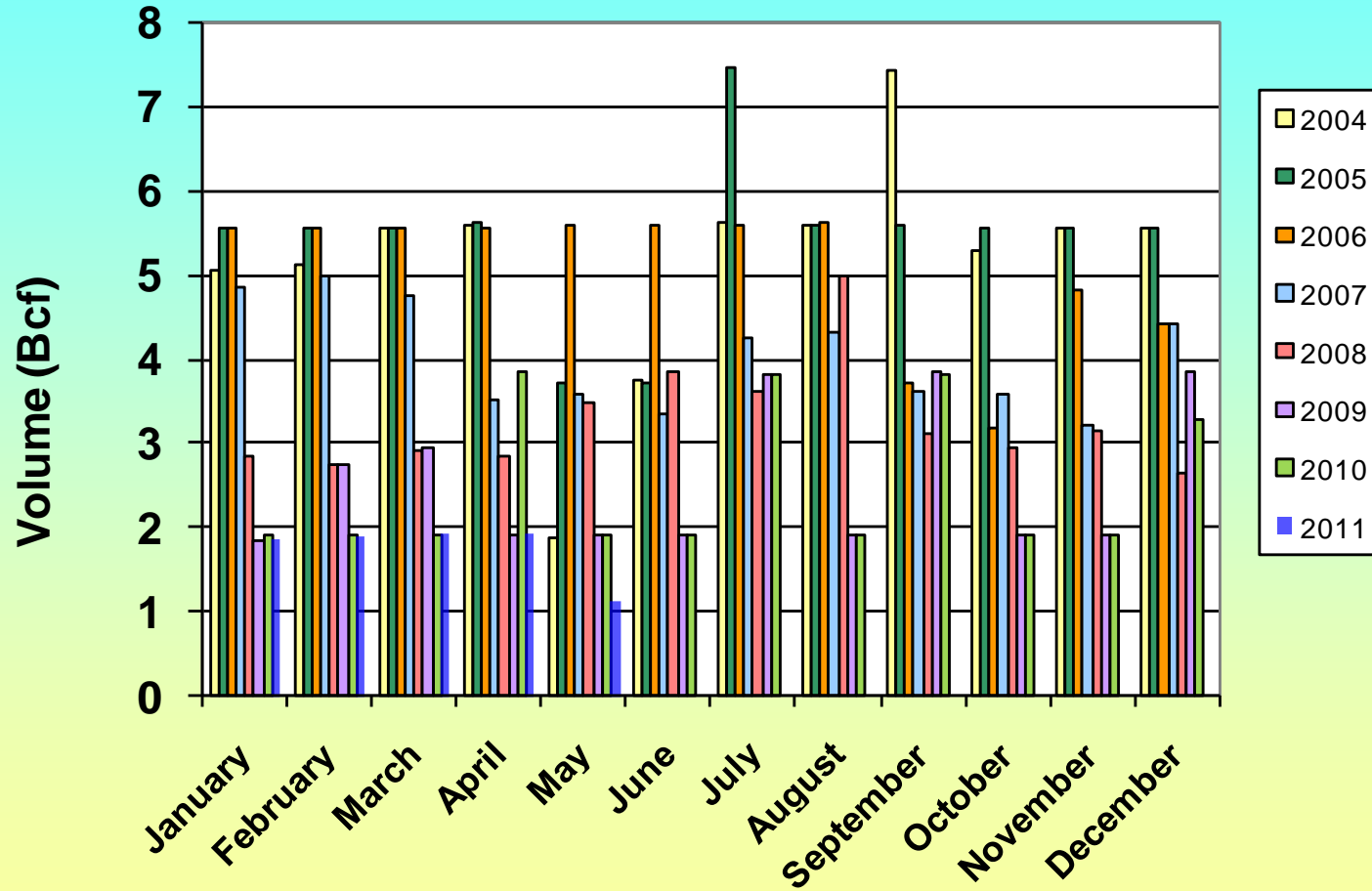
