ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR REHEARING
AND MOTION FOR LEAVE TO ANSWER
FOR THE PURPOSE OF FURTHER CONSIDERATION

AUGUST 24, 2015

On June 26, 2015, the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy (DOE/FE), issued a final opinion and order to Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC (SPL), captioned DOE/FE Order No. 3669, authorizing the export of liquefied natural gas (LNG) by vessel from the existing Sabine Pass LNG Terminal—specifically, from two additional liquefaction trains to be constructed at the Terminal (Trains 5 and 6).¹ DOE/FE authorized SPL to export the requested volume of LNG to any countries with which the United States has not entered into a free trade agreement (FTA) requiring national treatment for trade in natural gas, and with which trade is not prohibited by U.S. law or policy (non-FTA nations).

Subsequently, on July 27, 2015, intervenor-protestor Sierra Club submitted a Request for Rehearing of DOE/FE Order No. 3669. On August 11, 2015, SPL submitted a Motion for Leave to Answer and Answer to Sierra Club's Requests for Rehearing and Stay.

In order to afford additional time for consideration of the matters raised in Sierra Club's Request for Rehearing and SPL's Motion and proposed Answer, rehearing is hereby granted for the limited purpose of further consideration. Accordingly, Sierra Club's Request for Rehearing and SPL's Motion will not be deemed denied by operation of law pursuant to DOE regulations. 10 C.F.R. § 590.504.
