ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION  
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS  
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2677-A

On August 4, 2009, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Gibson Energy Partnership (Gibson Energy) in DOE/FE Order No. 2677 (Order 2677) to import and export up to a combined total of 2 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on September 1, 2009, and extending through August 31, 2011.

On November 19, 2009, Gibson Energy notified DOE that it no longer needs its current authorization due to a decision to reduce its natural gas business. Gibson Energy is no longer importing or exporting natural gas from or to Canada. Because the authorization to import and export natural gas is no longer needed, Gibson Energy requests that DOE vacate Order 2677.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada granted to Gibson Energy in Order 2677 is hereby vacated, effective the date of this Order.
