ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1116-A

On November 7, 1995, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Petro-Canada Hydrocarbons Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Petro-Canada, in DOE/FE Order No. 1116 (Order 1116) (1 FE ¶ 71,196) to export up to 150 billion cubic feet of natural gas to Canada over a two-year term beginning on the date of first delivery after November 30, 1995. No exports have occurred.

On October 25, 2010, DOE was notified that Suncor Energy Inc. and Petro-Canada were amalgamated to form a new corporate entity called Suncor Energy Inc. (Suncor). As a result of the merger, Suncor requested that Order 1116 be vacated effective October 31, 2010.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to export natural gas granted to Petro-Canada Hydrocarbons Inc. in Order 1116 is hereby vacated, effective October 31, 2010.
