ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA


DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2603-A

On December 24, 2008, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Integrys Energy Services of Canada Corp. (Integrys) in DOE/FE Order No. 2603 (Order 2603) to import and export up to a combined total of 100 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on February 21, 2009, and extending through February 20, 2011.

On December 23, 2009, Integrys requested that DOE vacate Order 2603, effective December 31, 2009. Effective October 1, 2009, Integrys sold nearly all of its Canadian natural gas and electric power contract portfolio to Shell Energy North America (Canada) Inc.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas granted to Integrys in Order 2603 is hereby vacated, effective December 31, 2009.
