ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA AND MEXICO,
TO EXPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS TO CANADA AND MEXICO, AND
TO IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS FROM VARIOUS INTERNATIONAL SOURCES

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2708-A

On October 7, 2009, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Energy International Corporation (Energy International) in DOE/FE Order No. 2708 (Order 2708) to import and export natural gas from and to Canada and Mexico, to export liquefied natural gas (LNG) to Canada and Mexico, and to import LNG from various international sources, up to a combined total of the equivalent of 200 billion cubic feet of natural gas, pursuant to transactions that have terms of no longer than two years. This authorization was effective for a two-year term which began on November 8, 2009, and extends through November 7, 2011.

On March 11, 2011, Energy International notified DOE that it does not intend to use its current authorization and as a result, requests DOE vacate Order 2708, effective the date this Order is issued.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada and Mexico, to export LNG to Canada and Mexico, and to import LNG from various international sources granted to Energy International in Order 2708 is hereby vacated.
