ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3001-A

On August 18, 2011, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to National Fuel Marketing Company (NFMC) in DOE/FE Order No. 3001 (Order 3001) to import and export up to a combined total of 73 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on November 1, 2011, and extending through October 31, 2013.

On May 25, 2012, NFMC notified DOE that it no longer needs its current authorization due to its closure of business effective April 30, 2012. As a result, NFMC requests that DOE vacate Order 3001.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada granted to NFMC in Order 3001 is hereby vacated, effective the date of this Order.
