ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION  
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS  
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3011-A

On September 2, 2011, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to ProLiance Energy, LLC (ProLiance) in DOE/FE Order No. 3011 (Order 3011) to import and export up to a combined total of 10 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on September 2, 2011, and extending through September 1, 2013.

On June 21, 2013, ProLiance notified DOE that it is no longer transporting natural gas from and to Canada, and does not need its current authorization. As a result ProLiance requests that DOE vacate Order 3011 effective June 30, 2013.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada granted to ProLiance in Order 3011 is hereby vacated, effective June 30, 2013.
