ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3054-A

On December 22, 2011, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Tenaska Washington Partners, L.P. (Tenaska) in DOE/FE Order No. 3054 (Order 3054) to import up to 43.86 Bcf of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on January 1, 2012, and extending through December 31, 2013.

On December 3, 2012, Tenaska notified DOE that it had negotiated an asset acquisition agreement with Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (PSE), whereby Tenaska transferred ownership of its Ferndale Cogeneration Station located in Ferndale, Washington, to PSE. The closing date of this agreement occurred on November 15, 2012. Tenaska states that beginning on November 15, 2012, it

does not intend to import natural gas from Canada as authorized in Order 3054. As a result, Tenaska requests that DOE vacate Order 3054, effective December 15, 2012.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas granted to Tenaska in Order 3054 is hereby vacated, effective December 15, 2012.
