ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3137-A

On September 18, 2012, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Constellation Energy Commodities Group, Inc. (Constellation) in DOE/FE Order No. 3137 (Order 3137) to import and export up to a combined total of 350 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on November 1, 2012, and extending through October 31, 2014.

On February 1, 2013, DOE was notified that, effective February 1, 2013, Constellation merged into Exelon Generation Company, LLC, and as a result, no longer needs the current authorization. Constellation has requested that DOE vacate Order 3137, effective February 1, 2013.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas granted to Constellation in Order 3137 is hereby vacated, effective February 1, 2013.
