Governor Martinez stated that LNG exports would stabilize world energy markets and reduce the reliance on countries such as Russia or OPEC. The Department of Energy must take action immediately because United States is competing against international LNG markets and there is limited demand.

Governor Martinez further stated that LNG exports will result in "net economic benefits" for the United States, generating thousands of new jobs, billions in investment and growth of GDP. LNG exportation would drive production, generating thousands of jobs.
