ORDER TRANSFERRING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 678-A

APRIL 20, 1994

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In DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 678 (Order 678), issued October 6, 1992, P.M.I. Comercio Internacional, S.A. de C.V. (P.M.I.), was granted blanket authorization to export up to 219 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas during the first year and up to 292 Bcf of natural gas during the second year of a two-year term, beginning on the date of first delivery.^{1/} The two-year term commenced on November 1, 1992, the date of first export delivery under Order 678. On March 15, 1993, P.M.I requested that the Office of Fossil Energy of the Department of Energy amend Order 678 to transfer P.M.I.'s authorization to MGI Supply Ltd. (MGI).^{2/} MGI is a corporation organized under the laws of the Cayman Islands and is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Mex Gas Internacional Ltd., with all outstanding stock held by Pemex Gas Y Petroquimica Basica (PEMEX GPQB). PEMEX GPQB is a decentralized agency of the United Mexican States and one of four subsidiary organisms of Petroleos Mexicanos (PEMEX) established as a result of the enactment of the Organic Law of Petroleos Mexicanos and Subsidiary Organisms on July 16, 1992, which substantially reorganized the functions and responsibilities

assigned to PEMEX under Mexican law. All functions related to natural gas in Mexico performed by PEMEX are now by Mexican law vested in PEMEX GPQB. Accordingly, pursuant of section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 678 is transferred from P.M.I. to MGI.
