ORDER TRANSFERRING LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 856-A


On October 1, 1993, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted Wisconsin Fuel & Light Company (WFL) in DOE/FE Order No. 856 (Order 856)^{1/} authority to import from Canada up to 10,398 Mcf per day of natural gas purchased from ProGas Limited. The authority began on November 1, 1993, and extends through October 31, 2003.

On November 30, 2001, the Office of Fossil Energy of DOE was notified that WFL had been merged with Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPSRC). WPSRC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of WPS Resources Corporation (WPSRC), is a corporation under the laws of the State of Wisconsin and has its principal place of business in Green Bay, Wisconsin. WPSRC provides wholesale and retail natural gas and electric service in northeastern and central Wisconsin and an adjacent part of Upper Michigan.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 856 is amended to substitute Wisconsin Public Service Corporation for Wisconsin Fuel & Light Company as the importer of natural gas. All terms and conditions in Order 856 remain in full force and effect.
